






A total of five health care startups were awarded
\$25,000, including Judge's Choice Award and Audience's Award winner CPRwrap.

 As a unifying convener for the health care industry, the Council's role took on even more significance in 2020. The Council Board released a powerful statement supporting diversity, equity and inclusion within the industry, and outlined concrete steps toward building a better future.

 The nation took note of Nashville's rich history and vibrant future in pieces published in Forbes, Modern Healthcare and Nashville Medical News.
